

Getting your prescription medicine

Your doctor has prescribed you some medication. What happens next?

- Tell your doctor if you prefer to pick the medications up in town or have them sent to your community clinic.
- Your doctor will fax the prescription to the pharmacy.
- If you requested that your medication to be sent to your community, our staff will pick up the medication and bring it back to the community clinic. We will call you when the medication is ready so you can pick it up.

If you do not hear back from us within a week, call the pharmacy. Sometimes things get lost or waylaid. If calling the pharmacy doesn't help, call the clinic.

Please keep track of the process and follow up if you don't hear from us within a week.
